### Itinerary:

#### Friday, August 3, 2018

- Depart from Calgary, Alberta
- Watch the excavation of Alberta gemstone Ammolite (fossil ammonite shells) and learn about the important fossils found at the Korite Ammolite mine
- View the "Hellboy" and Callum Creek dinosaur quarries near the Oldman River
- Overnight in Lethbridge, Alberta

#### Saturday, August 4, 2018

- Visit the Devil's Coulee Dinosaur and Heritage Museum in Warner. Tour the site where the first dinosaur eggs in Canada were discovered.
- Lunch at Writing-on-Stone Provincial Park. Learn about the geology of the area
- Search for dinosaur fossils near Manyberries
- Overnight in Medicine Hat, Alberta

#### Sunday, August 5, 2018

- Visit the Dinosaur Provincial Park Field Station.
- Hike in the Dinosaur Park Reserve and tour the quarries of several dinosaurs
- Overnight in Drumheller, Alberta

#### Monday, August 6, 2018

- Learn about the 72 million year old geology, plants and animals at Horseshoe Canyon
- Visit the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology galleries. On the back-room tour, see the fossil preparation and fossil storage areas
- Search for fossils in Horsethief Canyon
- Return to Calgary, Alberta

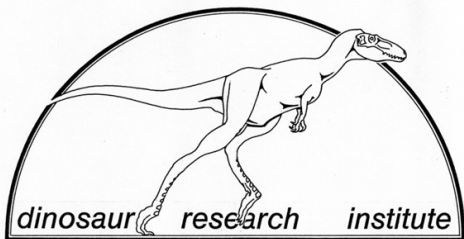

Dinotour is a unique opportunity to discover Alberta's palaeontological treasures with world-renowned scientists Dr. Philip Currie, Dr. David Eberth, Dr. David Evans, Dr. Eva Koppelhus, Dr. Michael Ryan, and Darren Tanke.

During this four-day family-oriented event you will:

- Learn about the dinosaurs of Alberta
- Explore several dinosaur quarries in Manyberries, Dinosaur Provincial Park and along the Oldman River
- Hike and tour various sites in Dinosaur Provincial Park and Drumheller areas
- Tour the Royal Tyrrell Museum and the Field Station at Dinosaur Provincial Park
- Tour the Devil's Coulee Dinosaur and Heritage Museum and dinosaur egg site
- See excavation of Alberta's gemstone Ammolite (fossilized ammonite shell)

**Dr. Philip Currie** is a professor, Canada Research Chair at The University of Alberta in the Department of Biological Sciences, former Curator of Dinosaurs at the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology.

**Dr. David Eberth** is the Research Scientist, Sedimentary Geology and Palaeoecology Research at the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology.

**Dr. David Evans** is an Associate Curator in Vertebrate Palaeontology at the Royal Ontario Museum (ROM) in Toronto, Ontario where he oversees dinosaur research. He is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Ecology and Evolutionary Biology at University of Toronto.

**Dr. Eva Koppelhus** is Assistant Professor and Curator of Paleobotany and Palynology Collections at the University of Alberta.

**Dr. Michael Ryan** is Coordinator of Research and Curator and Head of Vertebrate Paleontology at the Cleveland Museum of Natural History.

**Darren Tanke** is Senior Technician II at the Royal Tyrrell Museum of Palaeontology.
